TCT SCHOLARSHIP 2020-21

For high school seniors and continuing education students attending Northwest College



OBJECTIVE

TCT invites graduating high school seniors and continuing education students to apply for one of 15 scholarships being offered for the 2020-21 academic year. We have five (5) \$1,000 and ten (10) \$500 scholarships available. These scholarships will be awarded to successful applicants who will be enrolling at Northwest College. Scholarships will be awarded to selected students upon official proof of enrollment.

SELECTION

To qualify, applicant must be a TCT customer or a dependent of a TCT customer. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need, and student's accomplishments and community service record.

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships will be awarded to students who will be or are attending Northwest College. Students must be enrolled full-time, carrying at least 12 credit hours. Preference will be given to students whose vocational goals can be linked with engineering, computer technology, telecommunications, electronics, or associated fields.

REQUIREMENTS

- The following application must be completed in full, signed by both applicant and parent/guardian, and emailed
 to <u>tctscholarship@tct.net</u>. Submit application and all required documents in a single email if possible. Incomplete
 applications WILL NOT be considered.
- 2. Seniors must submit high school transcript through the 7th semester showing ACT and/or SAT scores.
- Continuing education students must submit the current official transcript from Northwest College. Applications
 will not be accepted from continuing education students until after a term has been completed and grades
 recorded on the official transcript.
- 4. Two letters of reference must be included with application; one from a teacher or counselor and one from someone not associated with your high school or post-secondary school.
- 5. If awarded a TCT scholarship, student will be required to provide TCT with their social security number.
- 6. All applicants must submit a current, suitable color photo (head & shoulder shot). Photo should be no larger than 4x6. If submitting electronically, a resolution of 300 dpi is preferred, with file-size no larger than 2MB, saved in JPEG (.jpg) format.
