Typical Scholarship Deadlines in October

Horatio Alger Scholarship Program:

State scholarships are awarded to eligible students in all fifty states and the District of Columbia. The program specifically assists high school students who have faced and overcome great obstacles in their young lives. The scholarships are funded by Horatio Alger Members who, like the Scholars, have experienced challenges but ultimately overcame them to become successful business and civic leaders. .

Criteria:

- high school senior in the United States; be progressing normally toward graduation in spring/summer of 2021 with plans to enter a college in the United States no later than the fall following graduation
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree at an accredited non-profit public or private institution in the United States
- Demonstrate critical financial need (\$55,000 or lower adjusted gross family income is required)
- Be involved in co-curricular and community service activities
- Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Maintain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0; and
- Be a United States citizen

U.S. Senate Youth Program Scholarship:

The US Senate Youth Program is a unique educational experience for outstanding high school students interested in pursuing careers in public service. The scholarship program has been fully funded and administered by the Hearst Foundation, since established by the US Senate Resolution in 1962; no government funds are utilized.

- Student body president, vice president, secretary, or treasurer
- Class president, vice president, secretary, or treasurer
- Student Council representative
- NHS officer
- Student representative

Daniels Scholarship Program (any school)

Criteria:

- Be a citizen or permanent resident of the US
- Wyoming resident
- Senior at PHS
- Demonstrate financial need (Adjusted Gross Income of \$85,000 or less on 2018 tax return. Please visit the website for more information)
- Earn an ACT score of 18 in each category (writing score not required) or an SAT Math score of 490 and Evidence Based Reading and Writing score of 490.
- Minimum high school GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale at time of application and upload an official transcript with application
- Recommendation from a school official (teacher, coach, principal, counselor, etc)

You must access the scholarship application online via the Daniels Fund website (DanielsFund.org). Application window is from October 1-November 15.

Hagan Scholarship Foundation (unique need-based merit scholarship)

Criteria:

- Must be a US citizen
- Must attend an eligible high school
- Must be a student in the graduating class
- Must have achieved a 3.50 GPA or higher
- Must score a 23 or higher on the ACT or 1150 on the SAT
- Must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university the fall semester following high school
- Must work 240 hours in the twelve months prior to the start of each academic year of college
- Must complete the FAFSA and the EFC must be less than \$6,500
- Must apply for eligible Federal and State grants
- Must not have been convicted of a felony

MSU-Bozeman Presidential Scholarship

Criteria:

- Apply for admission as an entering freshman
- 3.75 GPA and composite score of 30/ACT or 2000/SAT

Deadline for fall awards is typically the end of November. Applicants need to submit their materials by the end of November. Supportive materials (2 letters of recommendation, transcripts and the counselor verification usually need to be submitted online by December 10.)

University of Wyoming Trustees Scholarship (UW)

University of Wyoming Applications, official transcripts and test scores need to be submitted by December 1 to be considered for the UW Trustees Scholarship. A

committee will review completed applications and make selections based on the applicant pool reviewing GPA, test scores and academic rigor. Students who are identified to proceed to the next level will be invited to submit a resume and complete short answer questions. These materials are due in January. A committee will review candidate packets and invite finalists to UW for an on-campus interview scheduled in February.
